SeaSpace Receives Contract to Support the Meteorological Service of Canada

VIENNA, Virginia, April 13, 2006 – The Allied Defense Group, Inc. (AMEX: ADG) announces its SeaSpace subsidiary has been awarded a contract for approximately \$550,000 for the Meteorological Service of Canada (MSC) branch of Environment Canada.

The contract calls for SeaSpace to supply multi-mission ground stations for the reception and processing of data for the upcoming European Meteorological Operation (METOP) satellite. METOP will be the first of the EUMETSAT Polar System series of environmental satellites and Europe's entry into a set of operational environmental satellites. SeaSpace's ground stations will be installed at the Meteorological Service of Canada's Edmonton facility and at its Dartmouth location. The installation of these ground stations is planned to take place in July 2006.

The MSC is Canada's official source for meteorological information. The service provides public weather information, monitors atmospheric and hydrometric conditions, and conducts research on climate, atmospheric science, air quality, water quantity, ice and related environmental prediction issues making it Canada's source of expertise in these areas. Satellite data products derived from SeaSpace's ground stations will help support MSC's meteorological and environmental research and observations.

Major General (Ret.) John J. Marcello, Chief Executive Officer and President of The Allied Defense Group said, "We are pleased to support MSC with SeaSpace ground stations. With an installation base of over 450 customer sites, SeaSpace's TeraScan® System is the industry-standard remote sensing ground station."
