SEASPACE CORPORATION ANNOUNCES IT HAS INSTALLED A TERASCAN® X-BAND SYSTEM AT RUTGERS UNIVERSITY

SeaSpace installs a TeraScan X-Band System at Rutgers University Coastal Ocean Observation Lab.

Poway, CA., October 11, 2003 – SeaSpace Corporation announces it has completed the installation of a TeraScan® 3.6m X-Band System for the acquisition and processing of data from the Terra and Aqua satellites at Rutgers University Coastal Ocean Observation Lab (RU-COOL). The new TeraScan® system is co-located with an existing L-Band system. The existing system was also supplied by SeaSpace Corporation and has been in operation for over 11 years. The new X-Band system will be used for research work on the Lagrangian Transport and Transportation Experiment (LATTE).

“RU-COOL is excited to have the X-Band system in addition to its existing L-Band system. The new X-Band system will allow this operational lab to access real-time MODIS and Oceansat ocean color data during its adaptive sampling experiments, as well as provide inputs to their ocean forecasting models”, stated Ms. Jennifer Bosch, RU-COOL Director of Satellite Operations.

Kevin Davis, SeaSpace’s Director of Business Development stated: “The system at Rutgers University is SeaSpace’s 26th X-Band installation for MODIS data acquisition and processing, and SeaSpace is excited to expand our working relationship with Rutgers”.
