### **SEASPACE CORPORATION AWARDED CONTRACT TO SUPPLY MULTIPLE SYSTEMS TO DIRECCION GENERAL DE AERONAUTICA CIVIL OF CHILE**

*Poway, California, August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008*-SeaSpace Corporation announces a multi-million dollar award of several Meteorological Satellite Receiving Systems and IBL's Meteorological Forecasting, Display and Aviation Pilot Briefing Systems for the Department of Meteorology of Chile. The Department of Meteorology of Chile is within the Direccion General de Aeronautica Civil (DGAC).

Two new 2.4 m X-Band systems will be located in Santiago and Punta Arenas, Chile, and once installed, will push the total number of SeaSpace X-band systems to over 50 worldwide. The 2.4m TeraScan® X -Band systems utilize a 2.4m reflector mounted on a 3-axis positioner installed inside a 3.2m radome, and utilize high performance tracking antenna systems which provide both program track and autotrack of Low Earth Orbit (LEO) satellites. This contract will also upgrade the existing 13 TeraScan® ground stations including the ones located in Santiago and Punta Arenas, as well as those in Antofagasta, Puerto Montt, Isla de Pascua, and Antarctica.
